

Vision Care for Students in Need



Students in need at your school may benefit from the VSP® Eyes of Hope® charitable gift certificate program.

The program operates nationally through the National Association of School Nurses and other community partners to offer free eye exams and glasses for students who qualify.

Coverage Details

VSP Eyes of Hope gift certificates provide a comprehensive eye exam and prescription glasses at no cost. Certificates can be redeemed at a local VSP network doctor's office that offers the covered frames. Detailed instructions are printed on the certificate to make it easy for the student to share with their parent or guardian.

Eligibility

Certificates are available to students who meet the following criteria:

- Family income at or under 200% of the Federal Poverty Level guidelines
- No coverage through a private insurer or government program for the eye care services and prescription eyewear covered by the certificate
- Haven't used a VSP program for vision care within the last 12 months

Request Process

School nurses may request VSP Eyes of Hope gift certificates through the National Association of Schools Nurses at nasn.org or one of our other education partners listed at giftcertificates.vspeyesofhope.com. Alternatively, if your school or school nurse is not associated with one of our education partners, please visit partners.vspeyesofhope.com and complete the **Become A Partner** form.
